Coastal Boats FISA-type: 4X+, 2X, 1X, complying with FFSA gauge regulations for Mediterranean and French championship qualifying races.

Boats rental is possible subject to availability: reservations should be made latest February, 10th
- Terms: €15 per seat and per race including oars and safety equipment.

1X races may be cancelled at the organizers discretion in case of adverse weather conditions.

Course

The Monte-Carlo Bay course is an 2 x 4km (2 x 3 km for young rowers).

In case of adverse weather conditions on Saturday races will be postponed to Sunday in case of 1500 m in straight -line races.
