Pärnu

The people who chose to live at the river mouth thousands of years ago stayed here permanently. It is known that in 1154 the Arabian traveller and geographer Abu Abdallah Muhammed al-Idrisi serving the King of Sicily mentioned a river named Bernu.

Pärnu has become known as a summer and resort city. Since 1996, Pärnu holds the title of Estonia's Summer Capital and in 2006 the new beach promenade was opened to grandly celebrate the 10th anniversary of the Summer Capital.

At the end of 2004, UNICEF awarded Pärnu the title of Child- and Youth-Friendly City. The title means that Pärnu values working with children and the youth and that they are a target group who must be granted the best self-realization opportunities and a safe living environment.

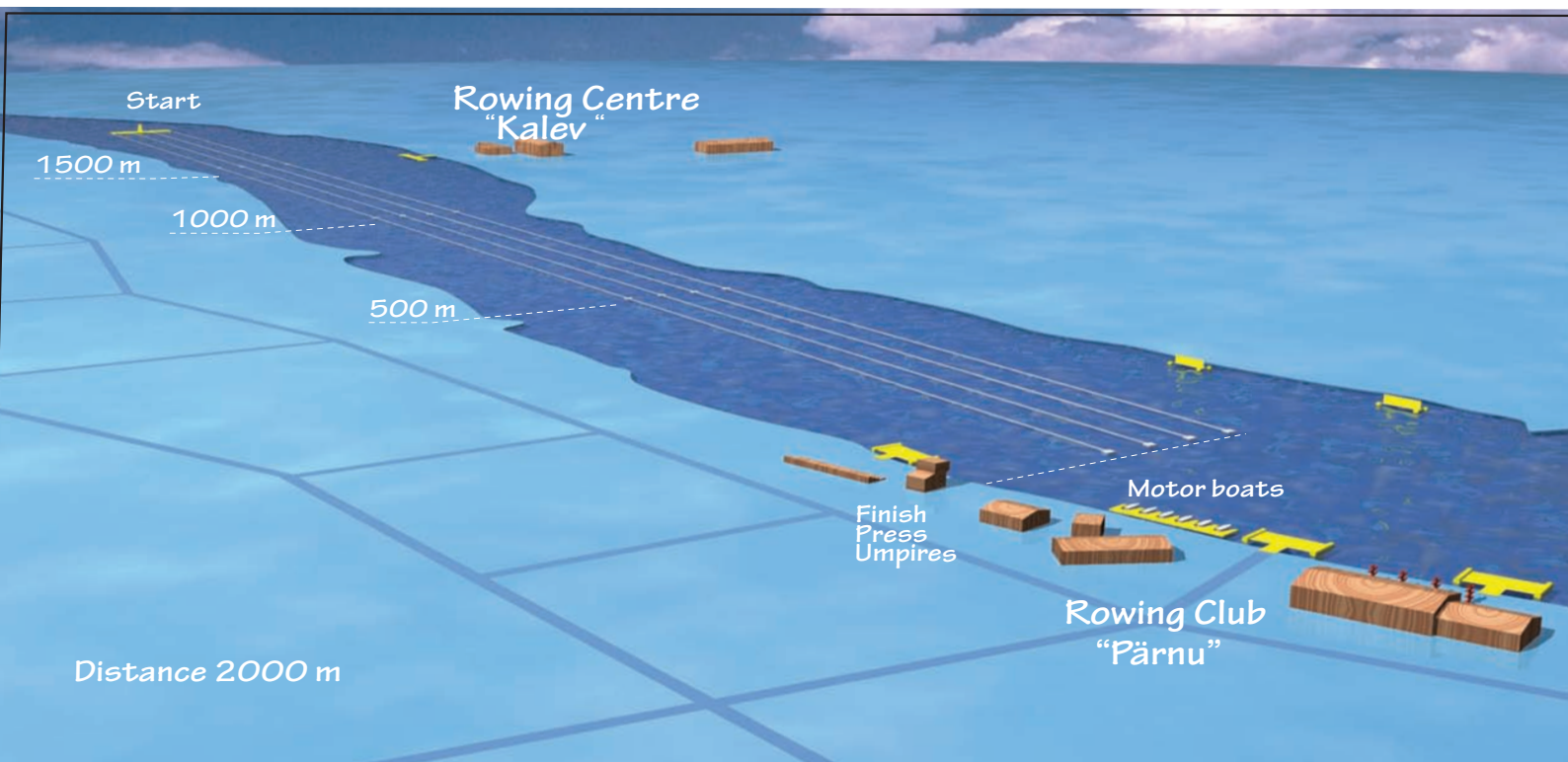

ROWING COURSE PÄRNU RIVER

The Pärnu is a river in Estonia that drains into the Gulf of Riga at Pärnu. It is one of the longest rivers in Estonia - 144 km long.

The course is located between two biggest bridges of Pärnu city. The distance runs towards the Gulf of Riga. The course on Pärnu river is the only distance in Estonia which allows to carry through competitions on 2000 m.

The finish and the finish area of the distance are located by the Rowing Club "Pärnu". Umpires and spectators are located this side of river also the victory ceremony will be carried out on Rowing Club "Pärnu".
