



CALL FOR PARTICIPATION NATIONAL ROWING SUMMER CAMP – YOUNG TALENTS

Art. 1 – Purpose of the project:

The Italian Rowing Federation (hereinafter also referred to as “**FIC**” or “**the Organization**”) hereby announces the **National Rowing Summer Camp** initiative, dedicated to the athletic and educational development of young athletes. The camp was created with the goal of promoting and spreading the fundamental values of sport, such as **fair play, inclusion, collaboration, and team spirit**, offering participants a formative experience that combines sports activities, educational moments, and opportunities for socialization.

Through the sport of rowing, the project aims to foster the personal growth of young athletes, contributing to the development of athletic, interpersonal, and social skills.

Art. 2 – Dates and Location:

The Summer Camp will take place **from July 12, 2026, to July 18, 2026**, in **Lignano Sabbiadoro**, at the “La Bella Italia Village” facility, which specializes in hosting sports groups and organizing sports and recreational activities.

Rowing training sessions will take place at the **Canoa San Giorgio** club, while beach training sessions will be held at the **Circolo Canottieri Lignano**.

Transportation to and from training sessions will be organized directly by the camp staff.

Art. 3 – Target Audience:

The camp is intended for **young rowers aged 13 to 16** (born in **2010, 2011, 2012, and 2013**) .



Art. 4 – Beginner Athletes and Membership

1. Admission of beginners:

Participation in the Federal Summer Camps is also permitted for young people who are not yet registered with the Italian Rowing Federation and who have no prior experience in rowing.

2. Participation Requirements

Beginners must meet the following requirements:

- be within the age limits specified in this announcement;
- a valid competitive sports medical clearance, as required by current regulations;
- ability to swim, as declared under the responsibility of parents or guardians.

• Annual Membership

Participation by newcomers is subject to mandatory membership with the FIC to ensure the insurance coverage provided for members.

To this end:

- membership will be arranged by and at the expense of the FIC and will remain valid until December 31, 2026;
- At the end of the camp, the participant may request a transfer to the selected rowing club by contacting the relevant Federal offices, tesseramento@canottaggio.org

Registration Procedures:

For registration purposes, the parents or guardians of new participants must:

- complete and sign all forms provided on the dedicated page of the federation's website <https://www.canottaggio.org/s74-campus-estivo/>
- Submit a passport-sized photo and sign the dedicated privacy form;



Art. 5 – Sports Activities:

The camp program includes **daily rowing training sessions** aimed at improving rowing technique, athletic conditioning, and boat handling skills.

Activities will be led by **qualified Regional and Federal Coaches** and will be enriched by technical and motivational sessions featuring special guest appearances by **Olympic Rowing Champions**.

Art. 6 – Recreational activities and social time:

The camp includes time dedicated to relaxation and socializing among participants, with the aim of strengthening team spirit and encouraging the sharing of experiences.

Extracurricular activities will include a **day at the village's water park**, as well as participation in entertainment activities organized by the host facility.

Art. 7 – Accommodation and included services:

Participants will be accommodated in a fully equipped facility with **full board**, including breakfast, lunch, and dinner. Included services comprise:

- meals from **dinner on the day of arrival to lunch on the day of departure**;
- accommodation in rooms equipped with a maximum of 4 beds each;
- daily room cleaning and sanitation of restroom facilities;
- bed-making;
- provision of small and medium-sized towels;
- access to **the private beach** with one umbrella, one sunbed, and one deck chair per room;
- Admission to **the resort's water park**;
- participation in the entertainment activities organized by the resort;
- **Wi-Fi access in common areas**;
- unattended parking within the resort.



Art. 8 – Educational and Regional Objectives:

The campus represents an important opportunity for **young talents from different Italian regions** to come together, fostering sports and cultural exchange and promoting the educational values of sport.

The initiative also contributes to the enhancement of the host region by promoting an educational sports model capable of generating positive social and cultural impacts.
